REQUEST FOR “TEMPORARY” REALLOCATION OF PINK ITQ HOLDINGS GUIDELINES FOR ATH AND ASB LICENSED SALMON VESSELS

This form must be completed if you wish to transfer all or a portion of your Fraser River pink holdings to another Area H or Area B vessel.

Instructions:

- 1) BOTH vessels must have a valid ATH or ASB licence and all fees paid prior to reallocation of any pink holdings.
- 2) For temporary pink reallocations, only one owner of record or authorized signatory of the licence eligibility holder is required to sign unless otherwise stated. If the vessel owner is a company, the Pacific Fishery Licence Unit must have on record a copy of either a confirmation of Signing Authorities or an Amendment to confirmation of Signing Authorities form advising who the signing authorities for the company are.
- 3) **A valid licence amendment must be on record with the Department while the vessel is engaged in fishing.**

Reallocation Guidelines

1. Upon application, vessel owners will be permitted to make unlimited temporary reallocations of pink ITQ.
2. Pink ITQ may only be transferred between Area H and/or Area B vessels (e.g. Area H to Area H, Area B to Area B, Area H to Area B and Area B to Area H).
3. Only uncaught pink ITQ may be reallocated. Sufficient quota share (%) must be retained to balance all catch to date.
4. Reallocations of pink ITQ for the season will be expressed as a percentage. Pink ITQ may also be transferred in pieces and will not affect the quota share.
5. To transfer the entire Area H quota, the percentage transferred is 0.10494% of the TAC ($8.5\% \div 81$). The 8.5% is Area H's allocation of Fraser River pink.
6. To transfer the entire Area B quota, the percentage transferred is 0.41071% of the TAC ($69\% \div 168$). The 69% is Area B's allocation of Fraser River pink.
7. Temporary reallocations will be for the current year only.
